

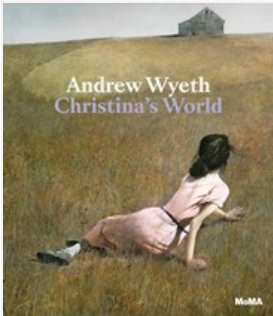

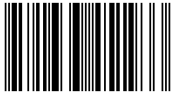


Andrew Wyeth: Christina's World
