Ways we can help

One way to help protect native wildlife is to keep your pet cats and dogs inside at night. An easy way to tell if it's ok for them to go outside is if you can see the sun.



Try not to ever use mouse or rat poison. If owls eat the dead rats or mice, the poison kills them tool If your parents do need to use poison, suggest researching first-generation poisons, which are less dangerous.



Owls, gliders and lots of other night animals need hollows to nest in. Trees do not create hollows until they are at least 50 years old, so it is important that we leave trees to get old and even keep dead trees for animal habitats. Unfortunately, many of these old trees are being unnecessarily logged as we speak. One way to help protect these old trees from being cut down is to show that you care and that you are not happy about animal habitats being turned into woodchips. You could make a sign and ask your parents to take you to a protest or write an email to your local member of parliament expressing how important it is that these trees are protected.



Animals need darkness and quiet at night to hunt, breed, navigate, communicate and sleep.
Light pollution can kill or harm animals by disrupting their behaviour and destroying food sources. If you're outside at night, try to keep quiet and don't use a super bright light.





Fill your birdbath at night too. Lots of nocturnal animals like bats and owls will appreciate a fresh drink, especially on hot summer nights.



It is just as important to plant flowering trees and plants that are native to your local area for nocturnal animals as well as birds and bees during the daytime. Flowers provide animals like bats and possums with important sources of food in the form of nectar and pollen




If you need to net your fruit trees, use netting with small holes (less than 5 millimetres) so bats, birds, snakes and mammals won't get tangled.



If you ever find an injured or abandoned nocturnal animal such as a possum, bat or bird, use a towel to gently catch them. Put them on a woollen or fleece blanket in a box with airholes in a quiet, dark place. If it's a cold night, fill a plastic bottle with hot water from the tap (not boiling), wrap it in a tea towel, and put it under the blanket. Contact your local wildlife carer, yet or ranger for advice on what to do next. Yets don't usually charge for treating injured wildlife.











ALL THE WATER THAT WILL EVER BE

Clouds, rain, streams, currents, waves... Water is always travelling and changing, and it is this ceaseless movement that makes life possible.

The Sun's energy plays a part in the water cycle, warming the surface of seas and oceans and causing some evaporation. The released water vapour rises in the atmosphere and cools, condensing into tiny droplets that float in the air and help to create clouds. If the amount of water in a cloud increases, the droplets become larger and heavier. When the air can no longer support their weight, the droplets fall to the ground as rain, snow, sleet or hail (precipitation).

Almost eighty per cent of this precipitation falls on the oceans, while the remaining twenty per cent falls on land, feeding rivers, lakes and aquifers before eventually returning to the vast open spaces of the oceans.

Is all seawater the same?

Far from it! Its salinity (salt content) depends on mineral salts eroding from rocks and soil over a long time. These salts dissolve in the water, but the amount of salt varies from region to region. The temperature and amount of oxygen in the water are also important factors that can vary enormously.

TIDES

We humans have always watched the tides go in and out. However, it wasn't until Isaac Newton proposed his law of universal gravitation that the sea's ebb and flow were examined with a scientific and experimental method. At last, the legends and myths that for centuries had tried to explain this intriguing process could be put to one side.

Nevertheless, with the direct connection between astronomical causes and their effects on Earth, it's easy to see how the regular rhythm of the tides inspired fascinating stories.

Today, thanks to scientific discoveries, we know that tides — when the ocean or sea level regularly rises and falls — are produced by the Moon's gravitational pull over water on Earth's surface. When one of Earth's zones is directly opposite the Moon, seawater is pulled towards it so that it bulges (rises and swells), creating a high tide.


On the side of Earth farthest from the Moon, the waters also rise, but this time it's because of the centrifugal force caused by Earth's rotation. That's why, all over the world, there are two high tides everyday.

If tides are predictable and constant, why does their strength change from day to day?

It's because they are also affected by the Sun. Like the Moon, the Sun pulls on seas and oceans, although its force is weaker than that of the Moon because it is further away from Earth.

Twice a month, the Sun and Moon are aligned and their tidal forces are combined. This produces more extreme tides, called 'spring tides'.

But when the Sun and Moon are at right angles to each other, the Sun has far less influence: the result is a 'neap tide', which is weaker than a spring tide and occurs when the first and last quarter Moon appears.



WAVES

It's nice to sit by the edge of the sea when the air is clear and calm, letting the water wash over your feet. All your attention is focused on the water, your eyes following its dancing ripples. Maybe you're wondering what waves actually are.

A wave is a circular movement of water that moves downwards from the ocean's surface to its depths until it reaches a point called the 'wave base'. But its energy keeps pushing forwards, drawing in nearby water to create a series of circular movements, until the whole expanse of seawater becomes agitated.


The waves grow higher as they interact with each other and tend to become more widely spaced. The distance between the waves at their highest point (their 'crests') is called the 'wavelength', while the 'trough' is the dip between two crests.


Wave motion begins in the open sea, in a zone called the 'fetch'. In the fetch, the wind blows continuously in a single direction across the water, transferring energy and movement to the surface. The water begins to rise and fall, creating small, irregular ripples that quickly turn into waves.


Since they hardly lose any energy, waves travel very long distances, but when they get near the coast... they trip over! This is because the seabed becomes less and less deep, making the waves unstable. Because the water moves faster the higher it is, the crests move faster than the troughs, rolling forwards until they 'fall' and break, producing a foamy surf.

Waves move energy, rather than matter, across the sea. That's why a tired seagull, floating on the water, is not carried towards dry land: it stays in the spot it chose to rest, rocked gently up and down in the sea's wide embrace.

Waves can be caused by other natural events, as well as by the wind. For example, when a rock crashes into the sea it can create huge waves. But wave motion can also begin beneath the ocean when underwater volcanic explosions and earthquakes result in gigantic, destructive waves: tsunami.









Pushsing the stomach out of its mount!

Sea star have two stomachs, the cardiac stomach and the pyloric stomach. They can push the cardiac stomach out of their mouth, in the centre of its underside, to engulf prey or insert it into prey (between twoshells, for example). The stomach then secretes a powerful digestive enzyme to break down the prey.



Sea stars begin by climbing on top of the prey using their tubed feet that function using a water vascular system. This means they take in water to their body through an opening called the madreporite and use water pressure to function their feet. If the sea star finds an animal with a hard exterior, such as a mussel, it can use this water pressure and tubed feet to open the prey exposing the soft interior. Some sea stars can apply 12 pounds of pressure when prying open prey!

When food is scarce, lobsters can turn cannibal and dine on smaller lobsters.

Lobster's teeth are located in its stomach!

These teeth are part of a system called the gastric mill which crushes food so that it is ready for further digestion. Lobsters swallow their food whole and the three teeth in their stomach act like grinders, enabling the stomach to do the chewing. From the mouth to the cardiac stomach, food is passed through the esophagus. Food is stored in this stomach until it is passed into the pyloric stomach, which is filled with small structures similar to teeth.



The average worker bee makes about 1,000 trips a year in search of pollen and nectar during its short life (about 6 weeks).




Bees can smell nectar sources up to 8 km away! This belps them find the flowers which they then pollinate and collect nectar from.

Bees have two stomachs!

One stomach for eating and the other special stomach is for storing nectar collected from flowers or water so that they can carry it back to their hive. Bees take pollen and nectar into the mouth. Salivary glands in the head and thorax help to break down food, which progresses through the digestive tract.



collect a sugary juice called nectar from the blossom by sucking it out with their tongues. They store it in what's called their honey stomach, which is different from their food stomach. When they have a full load, they fly back to the hive (2). Then pass the collected nectar to another worker. This worker holds the nectar on her tongue until the liquid evaporates, creating honey (3). The honey is then stored in a cell within the hive.






This complex digestive system is very efficient. The first chamber, the rumen, is a storage compartment where bacteria starts the digestive process. When the food is broken downd a bit by bacteria, they regurgitate all the way back up their mouth to chew a second time. After they swallow it and move the food to other chambers where the digestion continues.



THE TONGUE

Adult giraffe tongues are about half a meter long and dark blue. Their long tongues allow them to get extra reach for those super-high acacia leaves, as well as dexterously wrap their tongues around branches to strip leaves while avoiding the thorns.

The dark color of a giraffe's tongue is caused by a density of melanin color pigments, many believe that the melanin provides extra UV protection to prevent sunburn. Given that giraffes can feed for 12 hours a day with their tongues sticking out and exposed to the sun, so this theory makes sense!



Create a domino topple setup using books (or other objects). Normal tiny-size dominoes are NOT recommended and are considered one of the most unreliable items to use in Rube Goldberg Machines.




Final book should be placed at the table edge in front of the cup pyramid. Connect a string from the final book to the bottom center pyramid cup.



Place a piggy bank on top of the cup pyramid. Attach a string from the ceiling fan pull cord to the piggy bank.



Bend flyswatter handle to fit around a fan blade. Ask an adult for help installing. Alternatively, duct-tape a strip of cardboard to a single blade.



Ensure the wall switch to control ceiling fan is already ON, with the fan pull cord ready to activate the fan upon the next pull.

HELPFUL HINT

A lunchbox or any object that can balance atop the pyramid should work instead of a piggy bank.
