ICELANDIC

In the Icelandic language, the word for love is short and sweet: AST.

Icelandic is spoken in the country of Iceland, home to dramatic weather. In Iceland, some people believe if you dream of white sheep, then it will snow for as many days as there were sheep in your dream!



The short AST is perfect for snuggling in beside with other words to create different ways to give and receive love.





The word HJART, which means 'heart', can join ÁST to become HJASTKÆR, meaning 'dear to my heart'.

YORÙBÁ

'Love' in Yorubá is IFE.

The Yorùbá language has its origins in West Africa and is a spoken by millions of people in countries like Nigeria and Brazil.

In Yorubá, nicknames are one way to make someone feel special. Parents say OMO MI, meaning 'my dear child'.



In many families, sharing a nickname is a way to express love.

ARABIC

To say 'I love you' in Arabic, you say UHIBBUKA.

Arabic is the official language of twenty-five countries in the Middle East and North Africa.

Their alphabet has twenty-eight letters and is called AL-ABJADIYAH.

There are lots of words to describe love in the Arabic language.

You can even find a bit of love in everyday words such as 'seed'. The words for 'seed' and 'love' sound alike because they both come from the word HABOUBA which means 'to love'.

It offers a beautiful reminder that, like a seed, love can grow into something beautiful.





The word for love in Hindi is PYAAR.

Hindi is the third most-spoken language in the whole world. Over six hundred million people speak Hindi in the country of India and in many other places.

In Hindi, there are special words for the love shared in a family.

SNEHA is the enduring love from older people for youngsters.

VATSALYA is the one-of-a-kind love you feel from your parents.



CANTONESE

In Cantonese, the word for love is NGOI.

The Cantonese language is from Guangzhou in southern China. It is spoken by nearly 100 million people in Hong Kong, Macau and other countries.

Cantonese or Yueju, opera is admired all over the world for its music, costumes and face painting.

The Qixi Festival, or Seven Sisters Festival, is a celebration of love.

The legend of the festival tells of a family: One parent is magical, and one is from Earth, and they reunite on a bridge in the stars on this special day.

In traditional celebrations in cities like Hong Kong, streamers and lights decorate the night and people stay up late to spot the bridge and the characters from the story in the stars.



SINHALA

In Sinhala, the word for love is ADAREYI.

The Sinhala language is from the island of Sri Lanka in the Indian Ocean. Sri Lanka has had many names. One name means 'lion's island'.

There aren't any lions in Sri Lanka, but there is a historic palace called SIGIRIYA. At its entrance is a big carved lion to welcome visitors.



In Sinhala, to tell someone they are sweet or adorable, you call them KIRI, which means 'milk'.

Milk is an important part of special moments in Sri Lanka. During a wedding, a couple is treated to kiribath, or coconut milk rice, and a glass of milk to start their life together with the blessings of their family.

Māori culture has a very special greeting called HONGI.

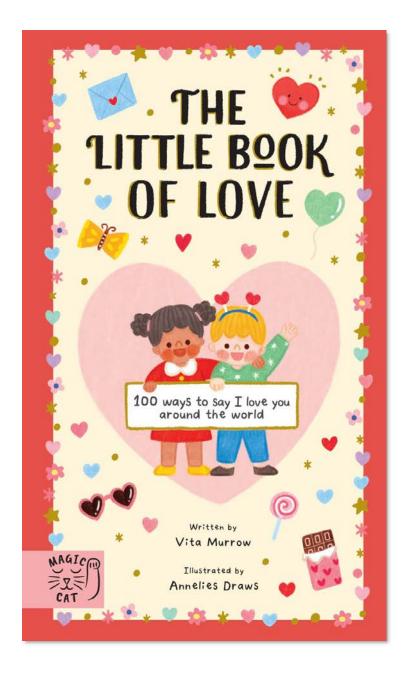
Two people press their forehead and nose together, close their eyes. and take deep breaths.

TERRIE ASKS: WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE FAIR?







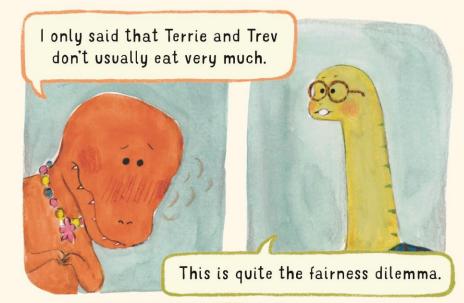


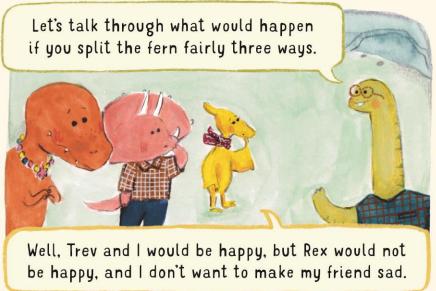

Yes, they do. Because they are adults, and they are bigger, and they need more food than I do.

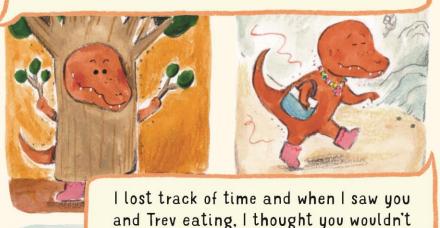
So, when we share, the **FAIR** thing to do is to share equally. But sometimes we need to share in a different way if our fellow dinosaurs need more than us.

But sometimes others need more than us and don't get the opportunities we do.



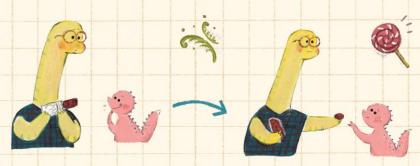

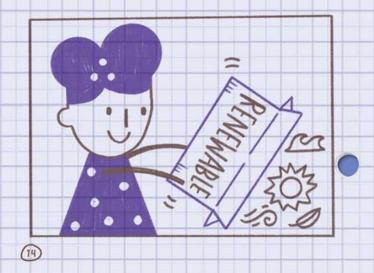
Our planet is filled with living and nonliving things. We get the energy to make food, to heat or cool our homes, and even to make books (like this one!) from nonliving things called **natural**

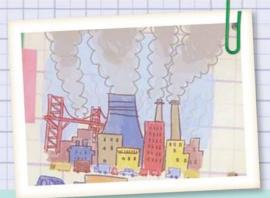




About one-fourth of all the electricity used in the United States comes from power plants that burn coal. Coal is a nonrenewable resource.

Remember what that means? After we use it up, there will be no more left on Earth.





The gasoline that powers our cars is made from oil found deep in the ground. That oil is also a nonrenewable resource.

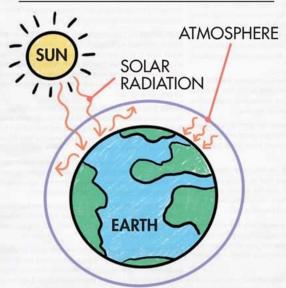


Burning coal and oil to create energy is also bad for our environment. When these substances are burned, they release **greenhouse gases** into the air.

Greenhouse gases like carbon dioxide trap heat in our atmosphere, and by doing so make our planet hotter. This process causes **global warming** and **climate change**.



THE GREENHOUSE EFFECT



Greenhouse gases get their name from greenhouses, which are clear structures that trap heat from the Sun in order to grow plants year-round.



RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCES

 SOLAR ENERGY from the Sun can be changed into electricity.



WIND ENERGY can
 also be turned into electricity.





- HYDROPOWER is energy produced by moving water.
