
- Glen Farmer Illortaminni was born between the mango and mulana trees where the last old house was standing at Milikapiti, on the Tiwi Islands.
- Glen joined Jilamara Arts Centre & Crafts Association in 1994 where he worked for many years as an artist and arts worker. He also worked at the Muluwurri Museum, a keeping place for Tiwi culture and an important place for remembering the old ways and the Old People.
- Glen's work has been exhibited across Australia, including in the National Gallery of Victoria and the National Gallery of Australia.
- Tiwi in Paris is a one-of-a-kind story based on Glen's experience being lost in Paris over five days, embracing Tiwi Islander storytelling and Glen's unique illustrative style.

Maya and Bailey had to travel on the train all by themselves, wearing tags on their wrists to say who they were and where they were going, so that they wouldn't get lost.







When Maya was four years old, she and her brother were sent to live with their grandmother in Stamps, Arkansas.


When a pawn reaches the opposite side of the board, it gets to promote to a queen, rook, bishop, or knight. It cannot promote to a king.







If all the pawns promote, then it's possible to have as many as nine queens on the board at the same time!



Chess pieces are often given a value. This acts as a rough guide to show how important each piece is.

### Material Value of the Pieces

8 Pawn = 1

Bishop = 3

Knight = 3


Rook = 5

Queen = 9


O King = Infinite








When fewer enemy pieces are on the board, the king no longer needs to be scared, and often turns into a true fighting piece. In this scenario, White's king will be the hero that helps its pawns win the game. When the enemy queen is off the board, it's usually safer for the king to join the battle.



The fool's mate is the quickest way to win (or lose!) a game -only two moves! This is something that may happen if you move the two pawns in front of the bishop and knight on the side next to your king. Only beginners fall for a fool's mate, so don't count on this happening!





Chinese chefs hand-pull pasta into long, skinny strings. Italians shape pasta into all kinds of things!



#### WHAT IS IT?

Mac 'n' cheese. Spaghetti and meatballs. Pasta needs no introduction! Pasta is usually made with just flour, water, and eggs.



#### **HOW DID IT CHANGE?**

Italians make their pasta from 100 percent durum wheat, also called semolina flour, which is higher in protein than the flour typically used around the world for pastas.



Italians have created over 1,300 shapes of pasta!



#### WHERE DOES IT COME FROM?

ITALY

Noodles existed in China more than 3,200 years ago. Although it's a popular belief that Marco Polo introduced pasta to Italians in 1292 CE, there is evidence that Arab traders introduced Sicilians to pasta even earlier, in 1154 CE.

## **CEVICHE**

Ceviche is typically made of raw fish cured in lime juice for a light, tasty dish.

#### WHAT IS IT?

Ceviche is a seafood dish made from raw seafood marinated in lemon or lime juice and seasoned with onions, chili pepper, and spices.

#### WHERE DOES IT COME FROM?

It's hotly debated where ceviche originates, but it is broadly believed to be from Peru, though in a different form.


In Peru, June 28 is National Ceviche Day.

was replaced with sour orange or lime. Japanese people immigrated to Peru around 1899 to work in the sugar cane fields, and they shortened the marinating time and added soy sauce and ginger as flavor ingredients.



#### **HOW DID IT CHANGE?**

Nearly 2,000 years ago, the Incas soaked raw fish for hours in a fermented corn beverage called chicha. The Moche civilization, who lived in northern Peru from 100 to 800 CE, used the juice of a local passionfruit called tumbo to "cook" raw fish. When the Spanish arrived around 400 years ago, they brought citrus and cilantro with them, and the tumbo







Between France and Belgium, French fries cause tension. Both think that fries are their country's invention.

#### WHAT IS IT?

French fries are sliced and deepfried potatoes. In Britain, they are called chips. But the rest of the world knows them as French fries.

#### WHERE DOES IT COME FROM?

Belgians claim that when the River Meuse froze in 1680, the people who deep-fried little fish along the bank substituted sliced potatoes, thereby creating the "French fry." American soldiers stationed in French-speaking Wallonia during World War I named the fried potato a "French fry," and the name stuck.



Belgium is currently petitioning the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to recognize the fry as a cultural treasure of Belgium, but France also claims the fried potato as its own.







"Move somewhere warmer," suggested one.









Soon he was snarled in string and had made an impressive mess.

"What is this horrible creature?" Bert thought. "A bridge? A piano? Could it be a nest?"








"I've never taught a bird before," Anni said, "but we'll start at the beginning—at zero, where I always start with students."


Anni showed Bert a plain wood square with strings stretched up and down. "This is a loom," she said, "and these are threads.
