#### Welcome

Did you know there are more trees in Australia now than there were in 1788 when the British came to colonise us and take our land? How could that be, with centuries of clearing land for farms and cities, for logging and from wildfires?

Aboriginal people kept this land healthy for over 60,000 years. How did Aboriginal people do it? Aboriginal people took their custodianship of the country seriously and managed it simply by working in collaboration with nature and not trying to usurp it – to change and control it. Country provided everything people needed for tens of thousands of years.

This book will surprise you and open your eyes to new ideas. Aboriginal Country taught people how to farm without fences, using firestick farming and other clever methods. There was no need to clear the land of vegetation or introduce hardhoofed animals that destroy Country and cause emissions. There was no need to treat native foods as pests and weeds to be eradicated.

Bruce Pascoe and Bill Gammage will show you that there is hope for the future if we look back at Aboriginal ways of working with Country, and learn from the past and current practices.

#### From Uncle Bruce Pascoe

My name is Bruce Pascoe, and I am a writer and farmer. You might have seen my book called *Young Dark Emu*. It's a book about my research into the way First Nations people cared for Country over many thousands of years. I am a Yuin, Bunurong and Tasmanian man, and I currently live on my farm in Gippsland, Victoria.

I'll talk more about my farm later in this book. But I also wanted to talk about how we act as Australians. We have a responsibility to care for this country. There are so many things here that are important. What do you want to protect and care for in Australia?


When I was at school it was like Aboriginal Australia didn't exist. The only thing I can remember doing was colouring in a boomerang. This complete absence made me very uneasy. It didn't make sense that Aboriginal people simply left the land when asked. 'Why would they do that?' I wondered. When older Aboriginal people helped me search for my own family they were cross with me for my ignorance of the real history of Australia and I made a promise to myself, and to them, that I would try to write books which told a different story.

I am so grateful to those old people; they made me responsible for oyster, plants and wallaby. In that way they ensured that I would have to look after the water, the land and the animals. It keeps me busy, I can tell you.

#### Chapter 1:

# Personal perspectives

What do you love most about Australia? Do you know what town you were born in or where you lived when you first arrived in Australia? Maybe you have a favourite memory of famous Australian things – koalas, kangaroos, the Sydney Opera House or Uluru. There are so many wonderful animals and places in Australia.

And we have a responsibility to take care of all of them. In this book we're going to talk about lots of different ways to do just that.



#### Chapter 2: by Bill Gammage

# Before and after 1788

What did Australia look like before the Europeans invaded in 1788? It would probably surprise most of us if we got to travel back in time to see Australia then.

When the Europeans arrived, they saw big mobs of grazing animals, skies flocked with birds and waters black with fish. They could see the bottom of Sydney Harbour because the water was so clear!

Another way the land looked different was because much of it wasn't covered in thick bush. Instead, it had large areas of grassland with few trees, even where there is thick bush today.




All in all, it's about managing our forests sustainably so that our grandchildren (you kids reading this book) can have forests too.

I will talk later about our farm, Yumburra, where we are growing the traditional Aboriginal foods and also trying to return the forest to the way it was when Lieutenant Cook arrived. Many other farmers are interested in making the forests less flammable and more useful to people.

Early European explorers described the land they saw at the beginning of the invasion as lush and open, pleasant and gentle. In those days there were fewer trees and small plants on the forest floor. The Europeans called it grass but mostly it was our root vegetables, such as the yam daisy and chocolate lily. There were no fences, apart from those used for game drives (herding animals to eat), because the land didn't belong to individuals; it was gifted to language groups and clans so that they would care for it, not exploit it.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander care for Country has been interrupted by the government. After 1788, First Nations people weren't allowed to care for their Country the way they had for many years, and so Australians began to see tangled undergrowth as normal. Timber operations removed bigger trees and made way for more undergrowth and scrub. But this undergrowth can catch alight very quickly.

- Bruce is based in Wallagaraugh, VIC and Bill is based in Canberra, ACT.



#### SETTING SAIL ON THE TERRA NOVA

Just four months earlier, on a warm June day in 1910, the heavily laden Terra Nova had sailed proudly out of Cardiff Bay in Wales.

Gathered on deck, beaming and waving at the crowds of well-wishers lining the shoreline, were Scott's team: a multi-talented cast of sailors, scientists, medics, officers, mechanics and even a photographer. They had been selected from more than 8,000 applicants.

The men were divided into two groups: the 'Shore Party' (33 men), who would be dropped off in Antarctica, and the 'Ship's Party' (32 men), who would sail the Terra Nova back to New Zealand for the winter. All being well, the ship would return to Antarctica in January 1912 to resupply the Shore Party, carry out further scientific work and collect anyone who needed to go home.

The Terra Nova would make her long journey south by way of Madeira, South Trinidad, South Africa, Australia and New Zealand, picking up more supplies and more colleagues along the way, most notably ponies and dogs.



#### TOM CREAN'S RABBIT

#### ANIMALS ON BOARD

Once they reached New Zealand, the team took aboard 19 Siberian ponies and 33 sledge dogs to help them in Antarctica. These were paid for by British and New Zealand school children. Each school 'gifted' their own animal. The ship's company also included a stowaway black cat - for whom the crew made a tiny hammock, blanket and pillow - and a rabbit, brought aboard by an expedition member, Tom Crean.







#### SHIP'S STORES

The Terra Nova was full to the brim with kit and supplies for the expedition, including flat-pack timber huts, scientific instruments, photographic equipment, and three state-of-the-art motor sledges, which Scott believed would revolutionise polar exploration.



#### FOOD AND LUXURIES

While many items were essential for keeping everyone on the expedition fed, watered and healthy, they weren't short of a few luxuries as well! Supplies included 162 carcasses of mutton, 1,000 pints of lime juice (to ward off scurvy), 35,000 cigars and half a tonne of tobacco, and they even took a gramaphone and a pianola for entertainment.




The long journey southwards aboard the cramped Terra Nova was a valuable time for the team to get to know one another. Officers, sailors and scientists cheerfully mucked in together, stoking the boilers and swabbing the decks. Not even the arrival of Amundsen's shocking news in Melbourne could puncture the jaunty mood.

On 26 November, amidst a blizzard of Union Jacks and cheering crowds, the Terra Nova left New Zealand's Lyttelton Harbour on the last leg of her journey to Antarctica. The ship was now so crammed with men, animals and cargo that Three days after departing, a raging gale unleashed its fury. Winds shrieked through the rigging, while mountainous waves pounded the decks. Two ponies and a dog died in the chaos and the crew were forced to throw tonnes of precious fuel overboard to keep the overladen ship afloat.


To make matters worse, the ship's pumps became clogged, flooding the hull and putting the Terra Nova in grave danger of sinking. The men resorted to bailing the water out by hand.



#### Who was Albert Bickmore?

He was the American man behind the museum. After his studies, he became a respected zoologist and fought to establish a major science museum in New York. His dream came true: The museum was built, and he became one of its first curators.

#### Real Life or . . . Diorama?

The museum houses many marvels beyond its world-famous mammoth skeleton and dinosaurs: minerals. meteorites, and, of course, the very special wildlife dioramas. You'll find these inviting landscapes behind glass, where the hidden worlds of wild animals in their natural habitats are revealed in lifelike, meticulously detailed artistic reconstructions. The dioramas are always a favorite, but they were particularly popular one hundred years ago when they gave New Yorkers the chance to travel to faraway lands



#### Don't Miss...

The Spectrum of Life in the Hall of Biodiversity teems with fifteenhundred specimens and models: insects, reptiles, mammals, birds, fish, and plants. This glass installation is 100 feet (30 meters) long, and showcases the astonishing diversity of life on Earth and the evolution of species spanning 3.5 billion years.



#### A Whale of an Honor

The museum also offers the Richard Gilder Graduate School, a PhD program in Comparative Biology. On graduation day, the students experience the perfect send-off: They receive their hard-won diplomas in the Hall of Ocean Life under the splendid blue whale, a life-sized reconstruction of the largest animal on Earth.



#### \* Insider Tip

American sculptor James Earle Fraser's Theodore Roosevelt statue that greeted visitors for eighty-plus years was removed in 2022 for its controversial "hierarchical composition." The bronze statue portrayed US President Theodore Roosevelt (1901-1909) on horseback, with African and Native figures walking alongside him.



The Northwest Coast Hall, dedicated to Native Nations of the Pacific Northwest, has been renovated with the participation of tribal descendants in the US and Canada. A must-see: the large nineteenth-century Haida and Heiltsuk dugout canoe, sculpted from a single western red cedar tree, 63 feet (20 meters) long. What's happening here? Tribal members are honoring the Great Canoe with downy eagle feathers.



Even if you live thousands of miles from New York City, you can get a great look inside the museum by watching the 2006 film Night at the Museum - and its sequels. In the movie, a night security guard (played by Ben Stiller) thinks he's landed a nice, quiet job, but instead he finds himself embroiled in a wild adventure. Us, too!



#### Origami Tree


During the holidays, the museum displays an origami tree, decorated with hundreds of colorful creatures hand-folded by origami artists. In 2023, the tree's theme was "Proboscideans on Parade," inspired by the temporary exhibition The Secret World of Elephants.





#### Working Behind the Scenes: Nancy, Curator, Department of Mammalogy

Nancy is wild about the world's only flying mammals: bats. She studies chiropterans that lived millions of years ago to see how they evolved, and takes international field trips regularly. That's how she helped discover a new bat species with bright orange fur in the Nimba mountains of West Africa. Congratulations to this fearless scientist!
