
EARTH PIGMENTS ON STRINGYBARK (EUCALYPTUS SP.)

Kitty Kantilla, also known as Kutuwulumi Purawarrumpatu, holds a special place in the heart of the Jilamara arts and crafts community, having played a pivotal role in establishing Jilamara Arts, the arts center in Milikapiti on Melville Island, the largest of the Tiwi Islands. At Jilamara, artists produce Tiwi art, with a particular focus on ironwood-carved birds and tutini (funerary poles); ochre paintings on bark, canvas, linen, and paper; and prints and screen-printed textiles. Kantilla's journey began on the eastern side of Melville Island, where she spent her early years hunting and gathering alongside her parents. Her childhood unfolded during World War II, when a man known to her only as "Mr. Moore" gathered the island's residents and displaced them from their homes before relocating them to Paru Crossing on the southern part of the island. Here, Kantilla and her family worked on a farm cultivating bananas, cashews, coconuts, and mangoes.

Kantilla was truly interdisciplinary in her artistic practice. She produced ironwood carvings of Ancestral beings, as well as tunga, single sheets of bark that have been folded and stitched down opposite sides to form a container. She was also a visionary painter, creating works on paper, bark, and canvas, and her unique approach to abstraction has come to defy conventional narrative explanations. Kantilla's art is deeply rooted in her heritage: for her, painting wasn't just about making something visual, it was also a harmonious fusion of singing, storytelling, and dancing. This selection of bark paintings represents an array of distinctive aspects of Tiwi culture, including yoyi (dance/Ceremony), jilamara (design/body painting), and yinkiti (food). When we look at these works, we are immediately immersed in a world of Ceremony, infused with Tiwi spirituality. For Kantilla, like many First Peoples artists, art wasn't solely a creative pursuit; it was a form of activism that allowed her to express her true self. In her own words, "The jilamara that I do, it's my father's . . . I watched him as a young girl, and I've still got his design in my head."




#### FASHION REVOLUTION

The credo that Alexander McQueen defended since his sensational entry into the world of fashion can be summed up in a few words: Fashion is more than fashion; it is an art in its own right, which, through the evocative, aesthetic, and symbolic power of clothing, makes it possible to express a vision of the world and the intimate universe of the designer.

Art historians and journalists have described his imagination using a wide range of labels, including gloomy, macabre, poetic, blasphemous, sexy, provocative, and sensual. His creations, interpreted by the models, reflected his inner world and served as a looking glass into society of the 1990s and 2000s, highlighting what was taboo and the darker facets of human nature and societal systems. Fashion became McQueen's medium for revealing the hidden layers of society and the unspoken impulses of the human spirit. His collection Bellmer La Poupée (spring/summer 1997) serves as a perfect example of this. Named after Hans Bellmer's work La Poupée, the collection echoed the surrealist artist's exploration of intimacy, the body's inner workings, and the depths of the mind. During the fashion show, McQueen presented elegant silhouettes and provocative outfits with unsettling eroticism, all worn by models confined within metal cages and pieces of iewelry by Shaun Leane that imprisoned them. McQueen not only revolutionized fashion with innovative wardrobe choices and aesthetic proposals, but he also explored deeper issues by questioning the very nature of the fashion industry itself. He transcended mere superficial concerns, subverting the culture of appearance and exploring intimate traumas and historical wounds. His revolution in fashion was characterized by shock and surprise, combining a genius for construction with extraordinary originality. Despite the audacious theatricality and rebellious spirit he embodied—as a sort of hooligan who challenged the luxury industry-it is essential not to overlook the clearly innovative yet sometimes hyperclassical perfection found in his garments.

The Untitled collection for spring/summer 1998 was centered around an S&M aesthetic that included sheer sheath dresses, leather and reptile skin garments, a black Lurex cocktail dress, and









#### CHICKEN SOUVLAKI WITH GREEK FRIES

Souvlaki is one of Greece's most popular street foods, and our favourite to eat all year round. Traditionally park is used, and sometimes chicken, lamb or beef.

If you're wondering about the difference between a souvlaki and a gyros, a souvlaki ("meat on a skewer") is made by threading places of marinated meat onto a skewer and grilling it over charcoal for added flavous. A traditional gyros usually uses pork, and is cooked on a vertical rotisserie; it's then shaved and added to a warm plab bread spread with tratiziki and topped with slices of tomato, finely sliced onlon, fresh parsley and fried potatoes.

Our souviaki recipe uses chicken thighs, marinated in the classic Greek marinade for most meats – freshly squeezed lemon juice, crushed garlic, dried Greek oregano, olive oil, and a good seasoning of salt and pepper. Avoid using chicken breast for these skewers, as the meat becomes too dry on the grill.

You will need six metal skewers for this recipe; if using wooden skewers, soak them in water for 1 hour before cooking, so they don't burn.

In a bowl, combine the garlic, lemon zest and juice, oregano and alive oil and season with salt flakes and cracked pepper. Add the chicken and tost to coat. Cover and leave to marinate in the fridge for at leave to marinate in the fridge for at leave to the covernight.

Preheat a barbeque or chargrill pan over medium-high heat. Thread 5-6 chicken pieces onto each skewe. Grill the chicken, turning frequently, for 15 minutes, or until golden brown and cooked through.

Serve the warm skewers with tzatziki and Greek fries.

#### A NOTE ON PREP

Marinate the chicken the day before grilling to help the flavour develop. On the morning of your gathering, pull the chicken from the fridge and thread it onto your skewers, ready for cooking.

#### SERVE ME WITH

A cold bottle of Greek beer. The souvlaki can also be turned into a gyros: remove the meat from the skwer and pile into a warm pita bread layered with Tirokafteri (page 20), some sliced tomato and onion, and Greek fries.

In a small bowl, whisk together the alive oil and vinegar. Season with salt flakes and cracked pepper.

Add the rusk pieces to the serving bowl and toss with the grated tomato and the dressing. Allow the rusks to briefly soak up all the beautiful juices – about 5 minutes should do.


To serve, crumble the feta over the salad and scatter with the dried and fresh oregano.

This salad is best prepared fresh, as you don't want the rusks to become too soggy.

Reduce the heat to medium and add the olive oil to the same dish. Add the chicken and sear for 5 minutes until golden brown on each side. Put the garlic back into the dish and add the wine. Cover and cook for 40 minutes, or until the chicken is cooked through.

Remove most of the garlic, leaving just a few cloves and the chicken in the dish. Set the dish aside.

Using a fork, press the garlic to extract the pulp from the skins. Transfer the pulp back to the the dish and add the cream. Bring to a light simmer over low heat for 5 minutes to thicken slightly. Taste and add salt or pepper if needed, then add in the parsley.

Serve the chicken over rice, pasta or mash and top with a generous ladleful of sauce.

Steak in pasilla sauce with potatoes Serves 4

GF DF V

The pasilla chilli is the dried version of the chilaca chilli. It has a unique, strong, bitter flavour and dark colour, and one of the best ways to use it is to cook pork or beef steaks in a pasilla sauce.

Chefs and cooks have to be creative with their comidas corrida if they want to win over the lunchtime office-worker crowd, so they need interesting menus that use seasonal ingredients, fruits or vegetables. This dish is not an everyday' menu item, but you'll find it at least once a month as a special of the week.

#### Method

Boil the chillies, garlic and peppercorn in 300 ml (10 fl oz) of water for 5 minutes. Remove from the heat and set aside to cool slightly, then transfer to a blender and blitz to a smooth sauce.

Heat 2 tablespoons of the oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add the pasilla sauce, salt and chicken stock cube, then bring to the boil and cook, stirring frequently, for 7 minutes or until the sauce darkens in colour. Add the potato and cook for 10 minutes.

Meanwhile, heat the remaining oil in a frying pan over medium heat. Add the onion in a single layer and place the minute steaks on top. Cook, occasionally turning the steaks, for 4–5 minutes, until the steaks are just cooked through, then add the onion and steaks to the pasilla sauce, reduce the heat to low and cook for 20 minutes or until the potato is tender.

Divide the steak, potato and pasilla sauce among plates, and serve with arroz Mexicano, frijoles negros and tortillas on the side.

Find the Small Magellanic Cloud, and Antares in Scorpius (p. 100). Draw a line between the two. Pavo sits one-third of the way along the line from the Small Magellanic Cloud. Its brightest star forms the head of the bird.

## BIOLOGY



- 3 cups (450 g) all-purpose (plain) flour, plus extra for dusting
- 3/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 4 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 4 teaspoons ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 5 oz (140 g) unsalted butter, room temperature
- 3/4 cup, firmly packed (165 g) brown sugar
- <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> cup (235 g) dark molasses
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

### Frosting

- 1½ oz (40 g) unsalted butter, room temperature
- 2 cups (250 g) confectioners' (icing) sugar
- 2 tablespoons milk

Combine the flour, baking soda, cinnamon, ginger, cloves, and a pinch of salt in a bowl. In the bowl of a stand mixer, beat the butter for 1 minute. Add the brown sugar and molasses and beat until combined. Add the egg and vanilla, beating for a further 2 minutes, then reduce the speed to low and gradually add the flour mixture, beating until combined and scraping down the side of the bowl as needed. Divide the dough into two halves, cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate until firm.

Preheat oven to 350°F (180°C). Line two oven trays with baking paper.

Sprinkle a work surface and rolling pin with flour. Remove the dough from the fridge and turn out onto the floured surface, sprinkling with more flour. Roll the dough to a thickness of ½ in (1 cm). Use cookie cutters to cut out as many cookies as you can, then transfer the cookies to the prepared trays, allowing 1 in (2.5 cm) between cookies. Roll up the remaining dough and repeat until you've used all the dough.

Transfer to the oven and bake for 8-11 minutes, rotating the trays halfway through. Test by gently pressing a finger into the center of a cookie – the dough should bounce back when cooked. Remove from the over then transfer to a cooling rack and allow to cool before decorating.

To make the frosting, place half of the butter, icing sugar, and milk into a stand mixer and mix until combined. Repeat with the remaining ingredients and continue mixing until the frosting is at your desired consistency, adding a bit more milk if needed.

Now for the fun bit! Scoop the frosting into a icing (piping) bag and start decorating!





All botanical pigments start with plants. In this chapter, I share an overview of some undemanding dye plants that are ideal for beginners to cultivate in the garden. I also include helpful guidelines for foraging plentiful species. Foraging, drying, and storing plant material follows a seasonal rhythm of being outdoors during the growing months and indoors, steaming in dyepots, in the fallow season. What and when we harvest influences not only the colors we concoct, but also how we use those pigments and what we express with them.

# Cultivating Colour

There are three ways to source dye plants: purchasing, cultivating, and foraging. There are many knowledgeable dye vendors who offer a widespread variety of plants. When working with a vendor, make sure to seek out a specialist, who can provide information on the specific plant species, places of origin, and best practices for working with them. Because dye plants are a natural resource and commodity, their provenance and production should be considered.

Many dye plants can be grown at home or in a community garden as well as foraged locally. These options foster a connection to place, demanding care and observation.

Whether purchased, cultivated, or foraged, any plants used for making lake pigments must contain mordant dyes (page xx), which bond to the mordant alum forming the pigments' core. As you flip through seed catalogs and familiarize yourself with local invasive species, compare those plants to the varieties listed in this book and in other dyeing resources.

In the following pages, I've included a sampling of plants to get you started. These annuals, biennials, and perennials are perfect if you're just beginning your journey into making lake pigments. Each yields a variety of different colors, some of which I demonstrate later in the book. Marigolds, for example, are a colourful and floriferous option for beginners; they're very forgiving of neglect

yet continue blooming all summer long. Before anything else, look up your local plant hardiness zone. This number corresponds to the average extreme temperatures in your region and is used to determine which varieties will thrive under your growing conditions. When selecting seeds, make certain your hardiness zone falls within the range suggested for each plant variety. It's helpful to source seeds cultivated in a climate like your own, be it from a regional seed vendor or a seed-savers' swap. Follow the guidelines for sowing, sun exposure, and water needs suggested by the seed supplier. This will give your plants a good start so they will grow happily in your local conditions.

It's also important to familiarize yourself with any regionally designated invasive species. Take care not to cultivate these, and remember that not every plant listed below and in this book is appropriate for every garden.

# Easy annuals

These plants are grown from seed in the spring and complete their entire lifecycle in one growing season. Leave some flower heads to mature and set seed in autumn; you can save the seeds in a cool, dry place to perpetuate your dye supply the following year.



4. Place 60g indigo leaves in a one-liter container, and cover with water. The leaves should be snug but not compacted. Push the leaves just under the surface of the water, weighing them down if needed with a sieve, small pot lid, or studio-dedicated fermentation weight. Do not seal the fermentation container or stir its contents. Leave the ferment in a warm place (75 to 95°F / 24 to 35°C), where it is safe from curious pets and wildlife. Outdoors is best, as it becomes aromatic over time. If the temperature drops too low, move the container to a greenhouse, place it on a seed germination mat, or tent it with dark plastic to absorb sunlight.




5. Check the ferment two to three times each day, noting the changes to its color and scent. Hold the container to the light or sample its liquid in a small jar to observe its color. Over hours or days, you will see the water first turn yellow (below, top), then green (below, bottom), then a magical opalescent aqua (left). This is colorful evidence of the indoxyl being released. You might notice bubbles rising to the surface, indicating microbial feasting. A crispy metallic sheen might appear on the surface of the water. A fruity, spunky, and briny aroma will develop. The ferment is ripe when you observe some or all these cues.



### PREVENTING OVER-FERMENTATION

If the scent becomes increasingly tinged with an unpleasant rankness, it is teetering toward over-fermentation, at which point the pigment quality declines. If you find yourself in this position, proceed promptly with the extraction recipe. (However, if the ferment grows truly foul, all the leaves wilt to a slimy yellow, and the liquid turns brown, then you may compost the lot and start fresh.)





# How to make a collage

Collaging is simple, but it is worth setting yourself up properly and learning a few basic techniques. For one of the collages in this book, I designed my own Christmas tree with a bit of a twist. Why choose baubles when there are so many other things you can hang from the branches! Here you can follow my process and hopefully pick up some inspiration for your own decorated tree.





 Cut out your preferred background from the book and gather your tools. It is a good idea to work on a cutting mat if you are going to use the craft knife.



2. Remove the pages from the book; it makes them easier to work with.



Each image has a light border. For easier cutting you may choose to cut around the border, which can be done with scissors.



 Alternatively you can get much more detail with a craft knife. Just take care while using them, and cut in the direction away from your fingers.



 I always build my collages using small blobs of adhesive putty to place them. This gives me the opportunity to revise my composition before sticking it down.



Your tweezers come in handy for placement when you are working with small images, as here.



7. I glue the images over a sheet of paper so I don't get glue on my table or mat. This enables good coverage right up to the edges so no peeling occurs.



8. Again, use the tweezers to place your images. Once completed, press everything down with a clean sheet of paper and place a heavy book on top until the glue has properly dried.

Love Parade, Berlin, 1991

It's hardly surprising that Berlin, a city divided for 28 years, would erupt into a hotbed of ecstatic culture once the wall came down. Abandoned buildings in former East Berlin were transformed into clubs. Tresor, a former vault, and E-Werk, a power plant, were two of the most iconic, filling industrial spaces with techno and acid house. Annual events like the Love Parade festival and the Tuntenball drag ball elevated Berlin into Europe's LGB capital. Visual artists flooded the city due to the number of abandoned buildings, particularly in Mitte and Friedrichshain. These spaces gave rise to a culture of squatting where groups with shared socialist ideals and an appreciation for anarchy lived and worked. This feverish do-it-yourself ethos reimagined a broken, divided city where cold war industrial relics became the infrastructure for a new culture of inclusivity and fervent self-expression.





# 5. Flying Copper (2003)

Flying Copper features an armed police officer in riot gear with a yellow smiley face and angel wings. The piece challenges the motives of those who are there to protect us, warning of the dangers of excessive authority.

Pictures on Walls accompanied this image with the words: 'Deluxe and very large screenprint of a flying pig. Apparently popular with the boys in blue (actually true).'

Flying Copper first appeared as a number of giant painted cardboard cutouts suspended from the ceiling at Turf War, Banksy's first major exhibition, held in a warehouse in East London in 2003.

Pictures on Walls released the screen print in 2003 as a signed edition of 150 and a numbered-only edition of 600. Banksy also created 63 Artist's Proofs in a pink colourway and eight Artist's Proofs in a colourway with a pink face, both published in 2004.

# 47. Love Hurts (2012)

Love Hurts portrays a damaged heart-shaped red Mylar balloon that has two plasters crossed at its top left and is caught up in a barbed-wire fence. According to Banksy: 'Love Hurts is obviously an iconic representation of the battle to survive a broken heart. It's an uplifting visual poem to that most fragile of human emotions that seem to move within us as if on a soft breeze.'

Banksy has used the Love Hurtz balloon theme in various works. In 2017, it was displayed as a painting in the Walled Off Hotel in Bethlehem. The same balloon was also painted on a Brooklyn street during his 2013 New York 'residency', known as Better Out Than In.

Banksy released the print in 2012 as an edition of just 16, all signed and hand finished by the artist. It was released only for an exclusive selection of VIP collectors and never made available to the public.





The story goes that when he was hiding under a rubbish lorry from the police, Banksy noticed a stencilled number on the tank and had a brainwave. He saw stencils as a way to spray an artwork quickly and efficiently and has made his own since. To make your own stencil, either draw your own image that works with just one colour or find a royalty-free clip art image online. For the best results, trace this artwork onto mylar plastic, vinyl or thick card. Take a moment to think about the light and dark areas. Anything you cut out will be the colour of your paint and anything you leave will be blocked out. You will need a craft knife or pen cutter, a cutting mat, some paint (spraying it is optional) and a surface (use paper or get approval from the homeowner to paint on any walls or furnishings). Good luck and take care!







#### UNCOMFORTABLE TRUTHS

In 1819 the official Spanish court painter
Prancisco Goya suddenly withdrew from
public life. He left Madrid and the court behind
and moved into a house just outside southern
Madrid, then the countryside. His wife and
most of his friends were dead; he was seventythree years old, sick, completely deaf and
isolated from the Spanish court.

He had produced some of the greatest works of the 18th and early 19th centuries, but he wasn't finished yet. The man who had once painted crucifixions, miracles, saints and priests started a new series of raw and brutal paintings, many of them without even a hint of God.

The series of fourteen works, which would later be known as the Black Paintings, was painted directly onto the bare plaster walls of his secluded country house and clearly never intended for public viewing. They were created during his later years in Spain, from around 1819 to 1823, and they convey his deeply pessimistic view of humanity, the most horrific of them being Saturn Devouring bis Son, a disturbing work that is both profoundly modern and uniquely representative of the 19th century, both human and monstrous.

Their dark and melancholic subject matter would cause them to be regarded as a prefiguration of modern art, but how did Goya get here from painting royal commissions?

#### FROM THE LIGHT TO THE DARK


Goya was a man from a middle-class background who rose through the ranks to reach the highest level of high society. In 1774 he arrived in Madrid from Zaragoza, where he was painting beautiful works in provincial churches. At first he worked on cartoons for the royal residencies, creating designs to be woven into tapestries for the royal palaces. This would initiate him his first contact with the Spanish royal family.

In 1789, the year of the French Revolution, he would be appointed court painter and eventually work for three Spanish kings – first, Charles III, the great reformer, then his son, the inept Charles IV, and then bis son, the tyrant Ferdinand VII. When Spain was occupied by Napoleon from 1808 to 1814, Goya remained in Madrid and even worked for the French occupying forces. Goya saw himself principally as a painter of portraits, which make up about a third of his painted oeuvre, and around 160 authentic portraits by his hand survive.

Two events would shape Goya's later works. The first was in 1792, when Goya was forty-six. He developed a mysterious illness, possibly an autoimmune disorder, which nearly killed him and caused him to go completely deaf. The isolation and challenges caused by his hearing loss shaped his worldview, driving him towards deeper introspection and influencing his creative output in remarkable ways. His

#### WILLIAM MORRIS: PATTERN PIONEER

Artist, designer, businessman, author, activities he energetically pursued during his lifetime, William Morris (1834-96) is perhaps now known most of all as the creator complete understanding of the possibilities remarkable for their variety, despite Morris's recognizable style, as well as for their longevity: from Trellis, the first wallpaper, designed in 1862, through the block-printed and woven furnishing fabrics for curtains and upholstery of the 1870s and 1880s, such as Strawberry Thief or Acanthus, to his last reproduced or adapted and recoloured to suit wallpapers and furnishing fabrics by Morris twenty-first-century tastes, whether printed on a summer dress or practical kitchen blind, company was founded in the 1860s, and a Morris's patterns are part of the fabric of everyday visual culture.

During his lifetime Morris was known just as much for his facility with words, as a poet. Lectures for design students his strongly felt ideas about the role of art and design, also revealing the innate contradictions between his success as a designer, manufacturer and retailer and his belief in a fairer society, in which humanity could live in balance with the environment. Along with other artists, designers and writers associated with the Arts and Crafts Movement, Morris challenged industrial


promoting functional but simple decorative design that restored power to craftspeople of natural materials and handmade techniques had a moral, life-enhancing integrity and purpose, requiring 'beauty, imagination and order' to 'give people pleasure in the things they must perforce use [and] to give people pleasure in the things they must perforce make'.1

The aim of this book is to highlight the Victoria and Albert Museum's collection of patterns designed for reproduction on and close associates. Like the V&A, Morris's mutually formative relationship was forged through Morris's many different interactions with the museum, such as his decorative scheme for the V&A's Green Dining Room of 1866, frequent visits to study historical textiles, and a collections-shaping role as an adviser to the museum authorities. After his death, his daughter May Morris (1862–1938) successfully campaigned for a permanent collection and displays to acknowledge her father's many contributions. 

#### WILLIAM DE MORGAN

(1839 - 1917)

Pioneering British Arts & Crafts potter and tile artist


Celebrated for his unique designs and innovative techniques, William De Morgan was the foremost art potter of the Arts and Crafts movement, producing thousands of designs for tiles, vases and dishes in a career spanning over 30 years. Inspired by the natural world, medieval motifs and the arts of the Middle East, he created a distinctive yet diverse repertoire of plants, animals, mythical creatures and ships, executed with captivating and often humorous charm. A lifelong friend of the artist and activist William Morris (p. xxx), De Morgan was influenced by Morris's ideals and shared in the belief that a designer should be involved in all stages of an object's production. Committed to making high-quality art for the home, De Morgan carried out countless experiments into the technical aspects of pottery production, and was described by his business partner Halsey Ricardo as not only an imaginative designer but also an imaginative mechanic, chemist and engineer.1 Although De Morgan worked collaboratively with a small team to produce his pottery, the designs and inventions used in its manufacture were entirely his own, including the successful revival of lustreware (ceramics decorated with an iridescent metallic glaze), a career-defining achievement,

Born in London in 1839, De Morgan was the eldest of six siblings and was raised in a liberal household. His father, Augustus De Morgan, was Chair of Mathematics at University College London, and his mother Sophia Elizabeth Frend was an advocate for women's higher education and suffrage. De Morgan attended University College School from the age of 10, joining the College six years later. Interested in art from a young age, he took art classes at Cary's Academy in Bloomsbury, a feeder school for the Royal Academy, which he joined in 1859. He was quickly disillusioned by the Royal Academy's uninspiring teaching methods and left after four years. However, his time there was formative for the students he met, including the artists Henry Holiday, Albert Moore, Simeon Solomon and William Blake Richmond, who later described De Morgan's 'commanding characteristic' as being 'unmistakably humour'.

Fear and confidence, two sides of the same coin, really. They will work in tandem to stop you, then propel you forward on your creative journey. But they're not the only friends you'll meet along the way. It's important to be prepared for anything and take it on the chin.

Hans Zimmer is one of the most decorated composers of our time. He has scored such popular films as Rain Man, Thelma & Louise, The Lion King, and most recently, Dune, for which he won an Academy Award.

While scoring *Dune* in 2020, he ran into many challenges; it was during the COVID-19 pandemic, so teams of musicians who would typically gather in real life to perform had to meet remotely. They'd send their recordings and then Hans would piece them together. Business meetings can be challenging

remotely, so I can't imagine how difficult it was to have musical meetings remotely.


Another challenge was even bigger. Seeing that *Dune* was a futuristic thriller, Hans wanted the music to sound different, almost unrecognizable. He had a musical vision that he could hear in his head, but the instruments needed to bring it to life didn't even exist. Talk about a challenge. As part of his process, Hans had to commission musicians first just to make the instruments needed to make the sounds he wanted before he could move on to scoring.

Having such a singular focus on your creative vision means blowing past any obstacles in your way to make it happen, as demonstrated by Hans. What might come up on your journey?

#### OVERWHELM

It's easy to let your mind wander way faster than your body can keep up. When you try to chase it, you're overwhelmed with all of the creative possibilities in front of you. When this happens, remember the adage: How do you eat an elephant? One bite at a time. In addition to the tried-and-true methods of relaxation-meditation, deep breaths, etc.give yourself permission to move slowly, one step at a time. If you're a super type-A personality like me, remember that overwhelm will actually cause you to be less creative by using too much energy, energy that could be put toward your creative endeavors. My antidote to this is a much-needed movie night-what's yours?

#### EXCITEMENT

Excitement is great—in small bursts. When you get a new idea and have a burst of excited energy, it's a great tool to use to see the task through in the short term. But prolonged excitement can fray your focus and lead to overwhelm. With creativity, the highs are high, and the lows are low—strive to keep your emotions in the cool middle ground.

#### DISCOURAGEMENT


Jon Kabat-Zinn, a mindfulness author, has one of the best quotes ever: "You can't stop the waves, but you can learn to surf." I love this quote because so often, especially when things aren't going our way, we start to feel discouraged. But keep in mind that you can't control everything around you, but you can control how you respond to it. Whenever I'm feeling discouraged creatively, I try to figure out how to surf the situation, and suddenly, I'm back in control.

Design a surfboard you could see yourself on to ride that wave of discouragement.

#### **EVERYTHING ELSE**

If you're doing it right, you'll experience a whole range of emotions while on your creative journey. After all, you're practicing curiosity and courage in a way you never have before. Use this as an opportunity to get to know yourself better and understand how you are mentally and physically responding to the things that come up when you dare to take a chance on yourself.

The tempered-steel blades (1) do the actual digging and hewing. The effective cooling of the waste compressed air prevents their becoming overheated. The grit loosened by the blades is removed via the upper suction channel (2) and the lower, brush-lined suction channel (3) to the pipe (P) and then via the duct to the scuttle (J) outside. When not in use, the drill can be moved on the coasters (4). After the preliminary work of the tempered-steel blades, the walls of the main shaft are smoothed by walnut rollers with steel grinding strips(5).



The hammer cogs (6) get the power from the cam unit (7). The shape of the cam unit causes a revolving ha mmer motion to the hammer cogs, turning the entire foremost part of the drill and resulting in the notching stroke of the blades. In order to reduce the revolutions, thus increasing the power of the blades, cog-wheel-reduction is applied (8). The drill is pushed slowly forward during drilling with the help of the creeping cog (9)

Naturally the energy for all this is obtained from the compressed air, which is conveyed through the red jet tubing previously mentioned (10) or (O) to make the propeller (13) rotate, which in turn passes the revolving motion forward by means of a corkscrew shaft. The insertion wheel (11) is added to make underground bends negotiable.

#### LOCK DOOR

The round, barrel-shaped lock door is situated under the main shaft. A normal rectangular door is built into it. The high pressure in the main shaft passes through the lock by means of the three red jet tubes of the compressed air supply (O), which is then conducted to the actual bore units. The turnvalve (Q) serves to shut off the shaft or duct.

While the rectangular door in the round lock door remains closed, the compressed air is forced to find its way through the red tubes (O). If the door is opened the pressure in the tubes disappears and the machine stops. Back through the lock door goes the tube for grit removal

(P), which connects by means of a bayonet mount (R) with the side duct. This duct is covered over with duct-covering planks (S). The grit is removed by the spent pressure in reverse from the machine and is conducted back via the channel (P).

To prevent the lock door from slipping off into the depths during vertical drilling, the expansion bar contraption (T) has been invented, by means of


which the whole lock door can be jammed in the curve of the shaft wall.


This is how the situation can be at any given moment: the parachute lift is at the bottom of the shaft just behind the round lock door. The drill is working at full capacity.

The grit is being removed via the duct and the scuttle and is taken outside.

The midnight break arrives, and the gnomes down below want to come up. They open the rectangular door that cuts off the air pressure from the machine, causing it to stop. Then they lift up a duct plank and pull on the rope that jingles the bell up above. The plank is then replaced.

The gnome engineer above turns the distributor with the cog bar so that the compressed air no longer gets into the main shaft but goes via the hole NI into the duct. At the same time he lowers the scuttle so that the compressed air does not escape through the gravel-removal tube, but goes straight down and blows the whole duct clean. This air reverses at the bottom of the shaft and comes up via the main shaft, blowing the parachute lift up in front of it. Alas, this is not done without creating a cloud of dust that fortunately does not last long. The gnomes get out, climb the ladder to the air lock, and leave their work site via the decompression chamber.

Also, don't just look to fill your well of inspiration from shops or other designers; restaurants are great sources of inspiration for lighting, placement of art, and floral design, and hotels are great for bathroom design. And look to museums or galleries for inspiration on how to hang, light, and feature art in a space. The wall colors at the Met are a master class.

3 Which shops do you find particularly inspiring? When I'm looking for inspiration, I try to seek out shops that other people in my field are not going to visit regularly. So I love Merci Paris, for example, but I'm not necessarily going to find an idea there that will feel unique.

I'm lucky that my job takes me to Europe at least twice a year, so some of the best inspiration comes from [shops in] some of my favorite European cities:

I also always visit perfume and jewelry shops when I'm traveling. They are usually great inspiration for featuring small things in a meaningful way, they usually have good art collections, and the lighting is always pristine.




- 4 Where should someone look to find interesting shops when visiting a new place? I always visit Paula Flynn's Shopkeeper's website, theshopkeepers.com, for small, intriguing shops to visit while I'm traveling. And our blog
- 5 Why is it important to see items in person before purchasing them? For furniture, I think scale is the numberone reason to view an item in person before making a purchase. Sometimes something is much bigger or much smaller than you imagine it will be. If you have your eye on something online and you're not able to see it in person, ask the shopkeeper to FaceTime with you so you can see it in human scale. Most of the small shops will be happy to oblige.

For upholstered furniture, often you want to sit on the piece before committing—most important for focal pieces like sofas and sectionals. Accent chairs can be more forgiving since not everyone who lives in or visits your house is going to use them every day.

For textiles, color [that you see online vs. actual textile color] is a function of how well your computer screen is calibrated, how well the photographer captured the true color, and how different the lighting conditions in the shop are from the lighting conditions in your client's home. Whether you're buying in person or online, make sure you're clear on the return policy before you take something out, as the color may shift once you place an item in your project.

# The Story of the Interior

How We Have Shaped Rooms and How They Shape Us

were often painted as landscapes. The fusuma of the Konchi-in temple in Kyoto were painted to resemble the landscapes beyond them with the real gardens to be revealed when they were slid back. In the Sala delle Prospettive in the Villa Farnesina in Rome, Baldassare Peruzzi painted the walls to appear as though a loggia, framing what appeared to be the city beyond. The interior of the Villa Barbaro by Andrea Palladio was painted by Paolo Veronese with allegorical landscapes, the ages of man and even images of astrology and the four seasons adorning the walls. Being

inside these rooms was not just to be transported into the landscapes outside and beyond their walls but also to be placed among the stars.


All of these rooms have in common the desire to perpetuate the illusion of their disappearance into the surrounding landscape through embellishment. Twentieth-century European Modernism strove to dissolve the enclosure through making the walls between inside and out transparent, 'universal' and seamless. Schröder House, designed by Gerrit Rietveld, who trained as a cabinetmaker, was conceived much like a piece of

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evolved to become seats of power and the place from which order was established in courts and empires. Throughout the fifteenth century. different parts of Asia were ruled by dynasties including the Ottomans, Safavids and Mughals who constructed palaces of elaborate splendour in Istanbul, Isfahan, Agra, Delhi and Lahore. The Topkapi Saray (palace) in Istanbul was the centre of the Ottoman government until 1856. Bedrooms in such palaces were private affairs that were clearly demarcated along gender lines. The bedroom of Sultan Murad III was a lavishly decorated space covered with Iznik tiles and calligraphic Qur'anic inscriptions infused with botanical imagery. In contrast to European bedrooms of the time, the chambers of the Topkapi Saray were strictly private and off-limits to functionaries and diplomats. Traditionally, the Harem was the part of the palace reserved for the women of the court, including female members of the royal family. Murad broke with this tradition and had his bedroom installed in the Harem, indicative of a more open approach towards ruling and effectively redistributing power to his mother and eventually his widow.

The private and public narrative of a bedchamber was played out in the bedroom of Louis XIV at Versailles. Unlike the privacy of the Saray, here the bed was an instrument or object of power from where the king could watch and order his courtiers, the cloying nobility and seduce his numerous mistresses. The balustrade surrounding the bed was the demarcation between who was allowed into his inner chamber and who was outside of it.<sup>12</sup>

Radical and experimental items of furniture are imbued with many of the formal values of their historic counterpart, but they may also contest how we position our bodies within or on them, contain political or social messages or employ new technologies in their material and construction. The Faraday chair by the design studio Dunne & Raby is an enclosure that hypothetically protects its user from electromagnetic rays. Described as a chair but really a daybed, it draws attention to the constant unseen radiation that surrounds us. Formafantasma's Ore

  2017, recycled electrical components to make furniture.

Streams project examines how waste from electronics, often neglectfully disposed of and sent to developing countries for reprocessing, could be redesigned to make new furniture, such as chairs. The Spanish designer Martí Guixé painted an off-the-peg cheap plastic chair to send a message that its lack of value made it useful and good quality. His argument was that this kind of chair is democratic, inexpensive, robust and its lack of perceived value makes it very valuable. Ironically his intervention made the chair become increasingly costly to buy. Innovations in which furniture and rooms intersect stretch the bounds of the relationships between sitting, sleeping, rooms and the body and space. Dutch architect and designer Rolf Bruggink inherited a family chest

of drawers that nobody else wanted, with the understanding that he could reorder the heirloom in any way he wanted. He cut away large sections and updated it with a new element in order to create contemporary furniture. It is an approach that he followed for his family home in Utrecht, the Netherlands. Bruggink used salvaged elements from the demolition of a building next door to make a new house. The interior was constructed using no drawings, instead the house was pragmatically fabricated according to the size and availability of the various materials that were extracted from the site.

The story of the interior as told through the formation of the room is as much about reusing old objects as it is about the creation of new ones. Interior architecture, design and decoration

# MEXICO CITY ESSENTIALS



#### STREET FOOD

In Mexico City, "street food" is both a literal reality (food prepared and served on the street) and a concept (hand-friendly food served in markets and casual restaurants). Mexican street food encompasses the standard antojitos (page 53) as well as hot dogs, hamburgers, and everything from street sushi (a thing) to the juice stands that are as ubiquitous in the city as taquerías. The following common street dishes, which you'll see throughout the city, are must-tries.

- Elote: Corn on the cob, usually with mayo, crumbled cheese, and other toppings.
- Esquites: Off the cob, served in a cup with similar toppings. For more, see page 55.
- Gordita: Masa dough stuffed with filling, patted into a round shape, and fried in oil. To garnish, the vendor slices partway around the perimeter and places salsas and other garnishes inside.

- Huarache: A huge oval tortilla, so named for its resemblance to the sole of a shoe ("huarache" means sandal), cooked on a comal with various toppings. Something like a large sope (see below).
- Pambazo: A torta dunked in salsa and seared on a comal. Tortas ahogadas, a specialty of Jalisco state, are like pambazos but saucier.
- Quesadilla: A tortilla folded around a filling and heated on a comal (page 55). In CDMX, quesadillas—despite the fact that queso (cheese) is in the name—don't automatically come with cheese. In parts of Mexico, quesadillas are formed by folding masa dough around a filling, pinching to seal, and frying in oil; in CDMX, these are usually called empanadas. Cheese sandwiched between two flour tortillas is usually called a sincronizada.
- Sope: A thick, flat tortilla with pinched edges, cooked on a comal with various toppings (also sometimes called garnacha, picada, memela, or pellizcada).
- Taco: A tortilla folded or rolled around a filling. A taco made with a flour tortilla and melted cheese is called a gringa. For more, see page 114.
- Tamal: Masa dough whipped with lard or other saturated fat (e.g., coconut oil, shortening) wrapped in corn husks, banana leaves, or other material. Usually the masa is folded over a simple meat or vegetable filling, and steamed. "Tamal" is singular; "tamales" is plural.

- Tlacoyo: Masa dough stuffed with a filling, patted into an oval shape, and cooked on a dry comal. Garnishes (which usually include nopales) are placed on top too (shown opposite).
- Torta: A sandwich made on one of two crusty rolls, bolillos (torpedoshaped and crunchier) or teleras (rounder and softer). Generally, these are filled with a meat and sometimes cheese, in addition to extra ingredients like beans, avocado, chiles, lettuce, and/or tomato. A torta filled with a tamal is called a guajolota.

The classic food trucks that represent Mexican street food for most people in the US are all but nonexistent in Mexico. Instead, the street stands (called puestos) usually have fixed locations—which some have held for decades—often with stools so you can sit semi-comfortably while you eat. These may be shacks with fairly extensive kitchens, or just an umbrella over a coal-fired comal. Most of the permanent covered indoor markets have sections with dozens of puestos, as well as others scattered around the market.

In general, you eat at the stand, availing yourself of the salsas, lime wedges, and other garnishes, then pay when you're done (because, after all, you may want another taco). You'll likely receive your order on a plastic bag-covered plastic plate or something akin to it, which you


return when you're done. Despite many tourist guides' efforts to codify the Mexican street food experience, there aren't any rules beyond what you would do anywhere you order at a counter: Ask questions (or point), be polite, and avoid stands with no customers at peak hours.


At the weekly street markets called tianguises (see page 57) that are held in most neighborhoods, there are street stands that are put up just for that day. These are often, effectively, sprawling outdoor restaurants that may seat fifty or more people, some even with menus and table service.

A place that primarily serves tacos is, of course, a taquería. An antojería is the word for a place that serves a range of antojitos, but you rarely see or hear the word; you'd say "Let's go get huaraches" rather than "I feel like visiting an antojería." Along the same lines, "vitamina T"—the cute term for antojitos, since the core ones start with a T—is something you might see referenced on social media or blogs but isn't much used in everyday speech or on signage.

Finally, don't be apprehensive about eating on the street. Many people do so daily, meat is almost always cooked well done (or close to it), and the last thing a puesto owner wants is for word to get out that their food is unsanitary.



# INTRODUCTION STILL BAKING / Less FUSSY

### MY LIFE IN CAKE

If you view my biography from a bird's-eye vantage point, it is blatantly obvious that baking or baked goods have always been part of my DNA. My baking fascination started early, and it continues to this day. But my life in cakes and cookies and brownies and bread was never predestined, it was always floating in the periphery—a bit circuitous and spotty, but in retrospect, it was always the surest thing about me.

Growing up, my mom was always happy to bend the rules of the food pyramid so that we could occasionally share cake for breakfast or bonbons for dinner, as long as I promised to keep our irregular diet a secret between us. Looking back, the quality of our baked goods at this time was questionable. We were not eating Parisian-level pastry. This was Florida in the 1980s. It was strip malls and franchises and quick-serve concepts; sadly, I can't remember crossing the door of a momand-pop cafe or bakery or restaurant during this time. We subsisted on boxed cake mixes, industrial- style grocery store cookies, and fast-food soft-serve. But frankly, I simply didn't care. I didn't know better yet. I was both happy to have whatever baked goods were available and to share a secret with my mom.

In college, I continued my alarming input of all things sweet. I ate my fair share of overly manufactured muffins wrapped in plastic and sad croissants that had the texture of white supermarket bread, but on occasion I was able to sample new

# Classic BROWNIE (REDUX)

MAKES 16 BROWNIES

The original version of this brownie recipe essentially launched Baked, a Brooklyn-based bakery I co-founded. The brownie recipe evolved from a dear friend, Lesli Flick, and went on to garner praise from Oprah (it was one of her favorite things), Martha Stewart, and dozens of media outlets and consumers alike only 6 months after the bakery opened. It was a bit intense and all at once, but our brownie did deserve it. Shamefully, brownies never quite get the same attention as chocolate chip cookies or funky shaped croissants, so I was happy to see this simple dessert get some outsize praise.

Given that the original recipe is iconic, I made only minor tweaks. First, I scaled it down to fit a smaller pan for smaller occasions. Second, I skipped the separate whisking in of dry ingredients in an effort to streamline the process and eliminate a bowl. Finally, I removed one egg from the original recipe to lean more into the fudgy brownie texture. The result: it is every bit as chocolate forward and heavenly as the one that changed our bakery overnight.

6 ounces (170 g) dark chocolate (about 70 percent cacao)

½ cup (115 g) unsalted butter

% cup (150 g) granulated sugar % cup packed (55 g) light brown

2 large eggs, at room temperature

2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract

% cup (95 g) all-purpose flour

1 tablespoon unsweetened Dutchprocess cocoa powder

1 teaspoon kosher salt

sugar

1/2 teaspoon espresso powder


Preheat the oven to  $350^{\circ}F$  ( $180^{\circ}C$ ) and position a rack in the center. Butter the sides and bottom of a light-colored metal 8-inch (20-cm) square pan. Line with parchment paper so that it overhangs by about 1 inch (2.5 cm) on two sides of the pan. Butter the paper.

Melt the chocolate and butter together using the microwave or double-boiler method (see how to melt chocolate on page TK). Stir occasionally, until the chocolate and butter are completely melted, smooth, and combined. Remove from the heat and add both the granulated and brown sugars. Whisk until completely combined, about 1 minute. The mixture will look a bit sandy, which is fine. Wait about 5 minutes, or until the mixture is near room temperature (you don't want to cook your egg).

Add the eggs and vanilla to the mixture and whisk until just combined. Do not overbeat the batter.

2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar

1 tablespoon honey

1 tablespoon Dijon mustard


6 tablespoons (90 ml) extra-virgin olive oil

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Please stop buying store-bought salad dressing. Unless it's ranch, you should make salad dressing at home. (Though I could argue homemade ranch is also better.) It's way more delicious than the bottled stuff and takes all of 5 minutes to make. Like many others in the book, this recipe is simply a starting point for you to take in any direction you want. Switch up the vinegar for citrus juice, leave out the honey or substitute it with maple syrup, throw in some herbs or poppy seeds, or stir in a tablespoon of mayo to make it creamy. Who knows, maybe you'll come up with your own favorite salad dressing in the process.

In a medium bowl, whisk together balsamic vinegar, honey, and mustard. Slowly drizzle in olive oil, whisking constantly, until dressing is emulsified. Season with salt and pepper. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to 1 week.

SOLA BUSCA One of the oldest complete decks in existence, 1400s these vibrantly colored cards were some of the first printed from engravings on metal, most likely during the late 1400s. Also thought to have been created in Northern Italy, an edition of the deck was acquired by the British Museum in 1845. In 1907, the Sola Busca family of Milan provided researchers with photographs of a hand-colored version of the deck that their family had passed down for centuries. Vividly illustrated with figurative drawings based on characters and narratives from ancient myths, the *Sola Busca* deck also features Latin numerals and lettering. Examples of early Italian engraving, the Sola Busca designs are widely believed to have served as inspiration for Pamela Colman Smith's illustrations for the 20th-century Rider-Waite-Smith deck, as well as for Lady Frieda Harris's artwork for the Thoth deck, also created in the early 1900s.









La plupert des shang a s'accompagnent d'une transcription des paroles prononcées par les personnages de l'illustration, texte souvent rédigé par l'artiste lui-même. Ces mois entourent l'image et indiquent qui les prononce. Les dialogues offrent des détails que l'illustration seule ne permet pas de déceler : par exemple, la première rencontre de deux personnages ou le fait que certains sont mariés et trompent leur conjoint. Il arrive que des estampes mettent en soène des femmes en danger, qui semblent résister activement à leur agresseur. Mais, en général, le « combat » est un jeu, ce qu'explicitent les dialogues. Cependant, les shang peuvent parfots représenter des soènes de viol, dans lesquelles l'agresseur est toujours figuré sous la forme d'un homme laid et débraillé, au pénis plus ou moins difforme.

Dans ces scènes, les femmes sont généralement sur un pied d'égalité avec les hommes. Elles ne sont ni soumises, ni fobjet du seul plaisir masculin. Les shong o mettent en valeur leur goût de l'activité sexuelle et la satisfaction qu'elles en tirent autant que pour les hommes. Outre les rapports hétérosexuels, on trouve des scènes ne montrant que des femmes ou que des hommes. Lorsqu'une estampe met en scène une femme seule ou en compagnie d'une autre femme, celles-ci emplotent couramment des jouets sexuels, mais aucune différence d'âge ou de rang social ne les distingue. En revanche, lorsqu'il s'agit de deux hommes, il y a toujours une différence d'âge, le plus vieux étant celui qui domine, reflet de la situation admise dans la société. Dans ces scènes, les jeunes hommes sont généralement des prostitués, appelés wokoshu, dont les services peuvent ausai être fournis par des verves.

Humour et fantasme sont des aspects importants des shanga, comme le montre notamment la soène de la plougeuse et des poulpes illustrée par Hokusai. La présence d'animaux est rare dans ces images, mais lorsqu'ils y figurent, d'est pour jouer un rôle actif ou passif. Par exemple, un chien peut participer activement aux ébats des fennnes, mais passivement à ocux de hommes. L'animal est parfois représenté avec un ocu partenaire naturel-le, comme un ocuple de souris, de châts ou de chiens. Il peut sussi s'occuper seul à une suire activité, comme dans la scène où un cheval pénètre un tronc d'arbre, estampe d'ue à Utagawa Dunisada (1786–1865), l'un des crésieurs les plus inventifs de shanga (III. p. 44/45).
